

Concordia University of Edmonton Winter 2022 Exchange Announcement

Concordia University of Edmonton (CUE), in Alberta Canada is offering face-to-face studies for exchange students in the Winter (Spring) 2022 semester. Full-time University of The Bahamas (UB) students, who meet the criteria, will have the opportunity to study at CUE for one semester. This exchange opportunity is facilitated through the student exchange agreement between UB and CUE.

As an exchange student you must register for a full load and pay your tuition fees at your home university (UB). If you are on the tertiary grant, then your tuition is covered by the grant. Students will be responsible for all other expenses, but will be eligible to apply for the Jane and Marcus Bethel Travel Award and the Janyne Hodder Award.

Interested students should submit their applications to the Office of Global Studies and Programmes (OGSP) via globalstudies@ub.edu.bs by **9am on Monday, September 13, 2021**. Please contact the OGSP if you have any questions.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be enrolled full-time at UB and paying any tuition fees regulated by UB at the time of application and for the full duration of the exchange;
- have at least two semesters remaining in their programme; and
- have a GPA of 3.4 or higher at the time of application.

Other Conditions

Applicants must also:

- enroll in a full course load at CUE;
- be able and willing to serve as an ambassador for UB and The Bahamas;
- be willing to share their CUE exchange experience while in Canada via online presentations and in person upon return;
- display high levels of commitment to their studies, emotional maturity, intellectual curiosity, self-drive, and an interest in the Canadian culture; and
- demonstrate a commitment to the local Bahamian community.

1. Use this link <https://concordia.ab.ca/student-services/registrar/timetables/> to ensure that Concordia University of Edmonton will be offering courses you can take during the Winter (Spring) 2022 semester.
2. Identify **at least 8** specific courses that you want to take. Obtain the course description and syllabus for each course. Meet with your Academic Advisor to discuss and confirm your choices.
3. Complete and sign the **Study Abroad Course Approval Form**. The form must also be signed by your Academic Advisor and your Unit Head/Department Chair. Use this link to access the form <https://www.ub.edu.bs/wp-content/uploads/2016/10/Study-Abroad-Course-Approval-Fillable-Form-Spring-2019.pdf>.
4. Write your **Letter of Intent (should be a maximum of one page, single spaced)**. Include your rationale for study at Concordia University of Edmonton and how the semester at CUE will benefit you in general, your programme of study, your 8 courses of interest (include the Course Codes and Titles). You must also indicate how the courses you want to take will relate to your future career.

Address your letter to the UB Selection Committee. Follow the guidelines for letter writing as you briefly, but clearly explain why you want to study at CUE for a semester. Remember to sign your letter.

5. In **ONE** email, attach all documents (items A – D) listed below and send to: globalstudies@ub.edu.bs (Subject line: **Concordia University of Edmonton – Winter 2022 Exchange Application** followed by your full name). Tick each box in the checklist below to make sure you have included all the required documents.

- A Proof of Identity:** A digitized copy of a valid passport or valid certificate of identity (should be valid until at least October 2022).
- B Transcript:** A digitized copy of your most recent transcript that shows all your UB courses, including the ones in which you are presently enrolled.
- C Study Abroad Course Approval Form**
- D Letter of Intent**

Applications are due into the OGSP (globalstudies@ub.edu.bs) by 9am on Monday, September 13, 2021.
