Academic Symbolism

The University Mace

The Academic Ceremonial Mace represents the authority of the Chief Executive Officer of the University. The Mace of the University of The Bahamas measures three feet in length and is made from native mahogany for its strength and beauty. It is topped by the University crest flanked by two flamingoes, a symbol of our heritage and brilliance and the national bird of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. The Mace was designed and carved by Andret John, a noted Bahamian artist who is famous for his sculptures.

The Presidential Chain and Medallion

The Presidential Chain and Medallion are symbols of the rank of President and the authority of the Office of President. The bronze medallion is antique silver-plated and depicts the University's crest. The chain, plain and unadorned, is joined to the medallion by the President's banner, engraved with the name of the University's President. Together with the Mace, the chain and medallion symbolize the continuing authority of the President of the University of The Bahamas.

Academic Dress

The wearing of caps, gowns and hoods at college and university functions dates back to the earliest days of the oldest universities. Modern academic regalia evolved from the kinds of apparel worn by monks and students in the eleventh and twelfth centuries to keep warm in the medieval castles and halls in which they studied.

The Gown

The gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress or rank or social standing. The sleeves of the gown indicate the level of the degree held by the wearer. A long pointed sleeve indicates the bachelor degree. The master's degree gown has an oblong sleeve cut in an arc with a slit at either the upper arm or wrist. The doctoral gown has bell shaped sleeves and may also have velvet facing and three sleeve bars or chevrons. The sleeves of a university president's gown bear four chevrons. The trimming may be black or it may match the degree colour on the gown's edging.

The Cap

The academic cap is a sign of the freedom of scholarship and responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square, symbolizing the book, although other authorities claim that it is a mortarboard, the symbol of the mason, a privileged guild. Trustees wear a six-sided cap, while the President's is eight-sided. The colour of the tassels on the cap denotes the discipline. The tassels on the mortarboards worn by faculty may be black or a colour indicating the degree. Those who hold a doctoral degree may wear a gold tassel.

The Hood

The hood is the most prominent feature of the academic costume and is lined with the official colours of the institution conferring the degree. It is edged and bound with velvet or the colour appropriate to the degree. At University of The Bahamas, the lining of the hood is royal blue and white representing the University's colours.

The Cord

The gold cord is worn by candidates graduating with distinction. The cumulative grade point average required for the award of distinction is 3.51 - 4.00, effective Fall 1998.

Mr. Fred Perpall

As CEO of The Beck Group in Dallas, Texas, Fred Perpall leads the firm's domestic and international design, planning, real estate consultancy and construction businesses.

Fred is actively involved in his community. He is Chairman-Elect of the Dallas Citizens Council, he serves on the board of directors of Dallas Medical Resource and is a Director for Triumph Bancorp (TBK). Additionally, he is on the Board of Councilors for The Carter Center and is part of the Atlanta Tipoff Club – the group responsible for awarding the Naismith Player of the Year trophy.

In 1996 Fred began his career in design and construction. He has been a registered architect since 2003 and was elected to the prestigious American Institute of Architects (AIA) College of Fellows in 2016. He is a part of the AIA Large-Firm Roundtable and previously served as ex-Chairman of the Urban Land Institute's Urban Plan. He is also a former Director at the Georgia AIA.

Fred earned an Associate of Arts in Architecture from the College of The Bahamas (now University of The Bahamas), a Bachelor of Science in Architecture and a Master of Architecture at the University of Texas at Arlington. He is an alumnus of the 183rd class of Harvard Business School's Advanced Management Program and is a former Americas Fellow at The Baker Institute at Rice University.

A native of Nassau, Bahamas, Fred played on the 1994 Bahamian National Basketball Team. He and his wife, Abi, live in Dallas with their daughters, Ava and Al

Laura Rosanne Adderley

Laura Rosanne Adderley is an Associate Professor of African Diaspora History at Tulane University, New Orleans, Louisiana where she has worked almost continuously since 1996. She works primarily as a comparative slavery historian focusing particularly on the 19th century and the era of slave trade abolition and emancipation. Although the bulk of her research has concerned British slave trade suppression and the Africans affected by it, her research has always had significant transnational components across multiple colonial and geographic boundaries, including interaction between the British and Spanish colonized Caribbean and North America.

Dr. Adderley received her primary and secondary education and Queen's College in Nassau and completed two additional years of high school at Philips Academy in Andover, Massachusetts. She holds a B.A. in History and Latin American Studies from Yale University and a Ph.D. in African Diaspora History from the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Adderley is author of the book, "New Negroes from Africa": Slave Trade Abolition and Free African Settlement in the Nineteenth-Century Caribbean, published in 1996 for which she was a co-winner of the Wesley-Logan Prize for African Diaspora History, jointly awarded by the American Historical Association and the Association for the Study of African-American Life and History. Dr. Adderley is currently working on several new book projects including a study of the earliest "liberated Africans" settled in Antigua, The Bahamas and Tortola during the 1820s.

Since 2013, Dr. Adderley has served as the administrative director for the Africana Studies Program at Tulane. She also serves as one of two Tulane representatives on the Board of the Amistad Research Center, and is a board member and secretary for the Association for the Study of the Worldwide African Diaspora. Additionally, she has had a range of community interests including work with an anti-racism organizing collective in New Orleans, human rights education with Amnesty International, and work for the Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Louisiana on the legacy of African-American Episcopal saint, Frances Gaudet. Her work on mother Frances Gaudet was recently supported by a faculty fellowship at Tulane's Taylor Center for Social Innovation and Design Thinking. Dr. Adderley is especially interested in how high quality public history projects can influence visionary public policies and strong community culture in the present.
