At COB, she served as Senator of the School of Business and Vice President of the Economic Society, earning her the 2015 Nassau Institute's Lecture Series Award. In the same year, she was selected as a research contributor to the National Development Plan of The Bahamas. Just recently, Ms. Thompson received the Commonwealth of The Bahamas Minister's Cup Award and the National Youth Award in Education in recognition of her outstanding achievements.
