Today, she is the sole proprietor of three stores on the islands of New Providence, Abaco and Exuma, with imminent plans for international expansion.

In 2015, Ms. Thompson obtained her Bachelor of Business Administration degree in Economics, with distinction, from the College of The Bahamas (now University of The Bahamas). She graduated with the Dienkabe Kureyang Memorial Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement in Economics and was nominated for the 2015 Bahamas Financial Services Board Student of the Year Award.

Two years later, Ms. Thompson obtained her Master of Science in International Trade, Strategy and Operations, with distinction, at the University of Warwick in the United Kingdom. She earned a first-class mark on her dissertation entitled, 'How could SMEs in The Bahamas Internationalize their Trade? An Examination of the Tourism Industry and Water-Based Tour Operator Sector of The Bahamas'.

Ms. Thompson has served in numerous leadership and professional capacities on national and international platforms. At COB, she served as Senator of the School of Business and Vice President of the Economic Society, earning her the 2015 Nassau Institute's Lecture Series Award. In the same year, she was selected as a research contributor to the National Development Plan of The Bahamas. While studying in England, she was selected as the Master of Ceremony for the 2017 Commonwealth Africa Summit.

Just recently, Ms. Thompson received the Commonwealth of The Bahamas Minister's Cup Award and the National Youth Award in Education in recognition of her outstanding achievements. She was recently invited to attend the 2018 Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting where she, along with other youth ambassadors from across the Commonwealth, will have the opportunity to meet with Heads of Government and Foreign Ministers to communicate youth priorities and issues affecting The Bahamas and other Commonwealth Nations.

Today, Ms. Thompson is an adjunct professor in Economics and Finance at University of The Bahamas where she continues to be a staunch advocate for education and entrepreneurship as well as youth and women empowerment.
