Academic Symbolism

The University Mace

The Academic Ceremonial Mace represents the authority of the Chief Executive Officer of the University. The Mace of University of The Bahamas measures three feet in length and is made from native mahogany for its strength and beauty. It is topped by the University crest flanked by two flamingoes, a symbol of our heritage and brilliance and the national bird of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. The Mace was designed and carved by Andret John, a noted Bahamian artist who is famous for his sculptures.

The Presidential Chain and Medallion

The Presidential Chain and Medallion are symbols of the rank of President and the authority of the Office of President. The bronze medallion is antique silver-plated and depicts the University's crest. The chain, plain and unadorned, is joined to the medallion by the President's banner, engraved with the name of the University's President. Together with the Mace, the chain and medallion symbolize the continuing authority of the President of University of The Bahamas.

Academic Dress

The wearing of caps, gowns and hoods at college and university functions dates back to the earliest days of the oldest universities. Modern academic regalia evolved from the kinds of apparel worn by monks and students in the eleventh and twelfth centuries to keep warm in the medieval castles and halls in which they studied.

The Gown

The gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress or rank or social standing. The sleeves of the gown indicate the level of the degree held by the wearer. A long pointed sleeve indicates the bachelor degree. The master's degree gown has an oblong sleeve cut in an arc with a slit at either the upper arm or wrist. The doctoral gown has bell shaped sleeves and may also have velvet facing and three sleeve bars or chevrons. The sleeves of a university president's gown bear four chevrons. The trimming may be black or it may match the degree colour on the gown's edging.

The Cap

The academic cap is a sign of the freedom of scholarship and responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square, symbolizing the book, although other authorities claim that it is a mortarboard, the symbol of the mason, a privileged guild. Trustees wear a six-sided cap, while the President's is eight-sided. The colour of the tassels on the cap denotes the discipline. The tassels on the mortarboards worn by faculty may be black or a colour indicating the degree. Those who hold a doctoral degree may wear a gold tassel.

Geography – White Technology – Gold

History – White Journalism – Crimson

The Hood

The hood is the most prominent feature of the academic costume and is lined with the official colours of the institution conferring the degree. It is edged and bound with velvet or the colour appropriate to the degree. At University of The Bahamas, the lining of the hood is royal blue and white representing the University's colours.

The Cord

The gold cord is worn by candidates graduating with distinction. The cumulative grade point average required for the award of distinction is 3.51 - 4.00, effective Fall 1998.

Commencement Speaker New Providence Ceremony

Ms. Aisha Bowe Founder and CEO, STEMBoard

You belong in any room you choose to enter." This foundational advice that Aisha Bowe now offers others was forged from her academic and professional experiences along with the realization that belief and persistence are integral ingredients for achieving one's goals.

Driven by a desire to achieve her dreams in spite of other people's doubts and the challenges of navigating environments where few looked like her, Ms. Bowe earned a B.S.E in Aerospace Engineering and an M. Eng. in Space Systems Engineering, from the University of Michigan. She than began what would become a high profile and prestigious career at NASA.

Ms. Bowe joined NASA's Ames Research Center where she worked as a Mission Engineer on Nanosatellite programs before serving as a published researcher in the Flight Trajectory Dynamics & Controls Branch of the Aviation Systems Division. Ames is well known for its world-class research in air traffic management, conducted in collaboration with the Federal Aviation Administration to make air travel safer, less expensive and more efficient for the flying public. Ms. Bowe's work focused on developing methods to maintain safe separation of air traffic and optimize fuel consumption within automated systems.

Knowing first-hand the importance of mentorship in the spaces that you wish to enter, Ms. Bowe founded the Hack<IT> STEM camp in Nassau with a focus on exposing hundreds of Bahamian youth to career options in the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) fields. As a person whose lineage is hails from Exuma, Ms. Bowe deeply cares about life in The Bahamas. Since inception of the camp, she was responsible for providing the event to hundreds of Bahamian students at no cost.

Determined to help inspire and make space for other minorities in technology, Ms. Bowe transitioned after six years of service at NASA to found STEMBoard an engineering solutions company, where she currently serves as CEO. In 2020, STEMBoard ranked in the top half of the Inc. 5000 fastest growing companies in America list. A primary mandate of her organization is to 'democratize technology' by inspiring those from under-represented communities to pursue STEM careers.

In response to the pandemic, STEMBoard launched LINGO, a self-paced, at-home coding kit, to help support educators and students in the new remote and hybrid educational structures imposed by distance learning. Today, LINGO is used by students worldwide

and is the chosen academic support tool of various private and public schools across the United States, non-profit institutions as well as programs sponsored by tech giants including Microsoft and General Electric.

Ms. Bowe regularly shares her story and message of self-empowerment in interviews and presentations worldwide. Her accomplishments as a speaker include the US State Department's speakers' program and she has been the subject of many articles in publications such as: Entrepreneur Magazine, Inc.com, Fast Company, Wired and Shondaland. She was a featured guest on NBC LX as well as The Kelly Clarkson Show and The Tamron Hall Show, two of

the most highly rated daytime talk shows in the United States. In addition, Ms. Bowe was the subject of an Olay/BET public service announcement promoting women in technology.

Ms. Bowe is a member of the National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE) and the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA). She has received numerous awards for her dedication to technical excellence and the principles of diversity and opportunity, including: The 2020 Outstanding Alumna Award - University of Michigan Engineering, The 40 Under 40: Tech Diversity in Silicon Valley, U.S. Women's Chamber of Commerce Emerging Star Award and NASA's Engineering Honor Award.

Her father, Glenroy Bowe was born and raised in Nassau and graduated from St. Anne's before moving to the U.S. to finish his studies abroad. She is also the granddaughter of Forrester Bowe of Exuma
