### 1.0 Introduction

The status of students enrolled in degree programmes at University of The Bahamas shall be designated as full-time or part-time.

### 2.0 Full-Time Status

Full-time status is maintained in the Fall and Spring Semesters when students register for twelve to eighteen (12 – 18) credit hours. Students who wish to take more than eighteen (18) credit hours per semester must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00 and must get permission from the relevant Academic Dean.

### 3.0 Part-Time Status

Part-time status is maintained in the Fall and Spring Semesters when students register for a maximum of nine (9) credit hours. Students who wish to take more than nine (9) credit hours per semester must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.

### 4.0 Summer Sessions

During each of the Summer Sessions, full-time and part-time students may register for a maximum of nine (9) credit hours. Students who wish to take more than nine (9) credit hours per session must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00 and must get permission from the relevant Academic Dean.
