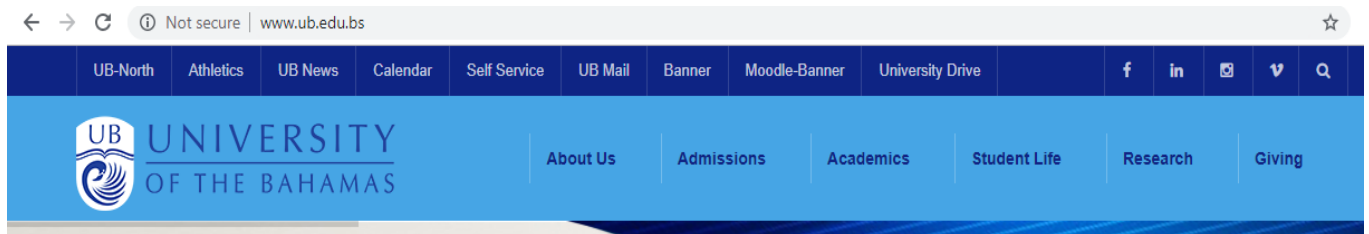




**BANNER - NAVIGATION GUIDE FOR

1. Navigate to UB's Banner Self Service Page at www.ub.edu.bs and click on 'Banner' on the home page.

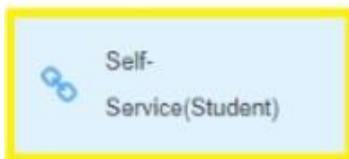


2. Click 'Self-Service(Student)' and sign in to your account.

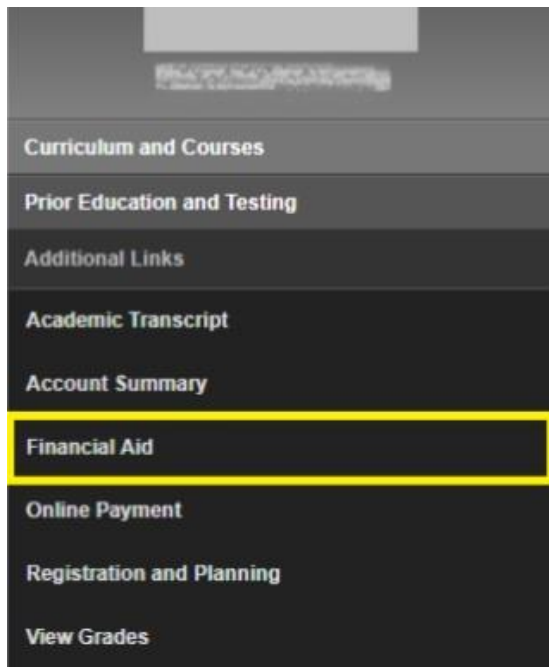



The University of The Bahamas Government Tertiary Grant Programme is intended to provide for the payment of tuition and course fees for all full-time Bahamian students of the institution, subject to the eligibility criteria as stated. Students are not compelled to be a part of the grant programme. Students may be funded by a private award, or opt to pay their own tuition.

Criteria for Bahamas Government Tertiary Grant Programme

To be eligible for the Bahamas Government Tertiary Grant Programme, the student must:

- be a Bahamian citizen;
- be a full-time enrolled student (new and returning), that is, be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits per semester;
- maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00;
- remain in satisfactory academic and disciplinary standing with the University.
