The policies will need to be revised by the Academic Policies Committee after they are passed as a result of the one year renewal period.

There was a discussion on definitions. It was agreed that the definitions of the same terms must be the same across all four policies.

There was a discussion regarding how disability is determined and the time frame in which students could ask for accommodations. Senators were referred to the Policy on Students with Disabilities and M. Woodside-Oriakhi noted that students are asked to self-identify upon admission to the University.
