- a. The Chair of the Academic Senate noted that the graduation awards were expected to be ready at next extraordinary meetings scheduled for the 15^{th} May 2023 at 9:30 a.m. 3:30 p.m. and the 16^{th} May 2023 at 9:30 a.m.
- b. She further noted that according to the By-laws, the Academic Senate was required to have an Ordinary meeting during the summer. It was being proposed that the meeting be held on the 20th June 2023. There are amendments to committee Terms of Reference, Committee reports and the draft of the Faculty Handbook that will need to be discussed at that meeting
- c. The Chair allowed E. Bethel to make an intervention The Secretary had brought to his attention that in the current Statues and By-laws there was no clear language about student senators at meeting at which student awards were discussed. When the Academic Senate revised the Bye-Laws last year the proposed a revision on this matter was omitted in the approved document. Although the Academic Senate clearly agreed that students should not be at meetings at which students wards are discussed, this is not in the current Bye-Laws. E. Bethel proposed that the words for insertion should be:
 - 5.1.1.5. Student Senators shall not attend any ordinary or extraordinary meetings at which student awards are approved or discussed.

He would like to propose that the Academic Senate approve this inclusion at its June meeting.
