University of The Bahamas North is pleased to invite applications for the position of Nurse Counsellor. This full-time appointment will commence January 2023. This position reports to the Interim Dean of Student Affairs, UB North.

Responsibilities: The Nurse Counsellor is tasked to supervise the Health Center's day-to-day service operations. The position of Nurse Counsellor is required to perform a variety of tasks including, but not limited to, the following:

- Assist with developing policies, procedures and work standards for health care services and program;
- Work shifts as needed and travel for training and University related events;
- Prepare and execute educational programs;
- Works closely with the Director of Health Services;
- Monitors compliance of school health program with local laws, regulations and policies;
- Formulates training programs as needed;
- Assists with preparing health reports for the Director of Health Services; and Dean of Student Affairs;
- Collaborates with support agencies in designing and providing a campus wide health program;
- Negotiates professional and medical services essential to the University's health program;
- Provides first aid care and medically prescribed services;
- Maintains/ ordering of health/medical supplies;
- Serves as a resource person on health issues;
- Provides staff education on health-related topics for University staff and volunteers;
- Appraises all health admission documents and provides clearance prior to registration;
- Screens and conducts health appraisals for students, faculty and staff;
- Provides follow-up evaluations on students as required;
- Recommends corrective action where problems are identified;
- Administers and records immunizations, health findings, and other relevant health data;

- Administers oral, intramuscular, and intravenous medication as necessary;
- Establishes personal rapport with patients in order to fully understand their healthcare requirements;
- Provides physical, psychological, and emotional support to patients and their families;
- Ensures compliance with nursing philosophies and therapeutic standards;
- Adheres to infection control procedures to ensure a safe and clean patient environment;
- Documents and communicates actions or irregularities in order to maintain continuity among nursing teams;
- Protects patient information by maintaining confidentiality of patient test results and other sensitive documents;
- Maintains nursing inventory by checking stock to identify available supplies and determine the need for restocking;
- Complies with manufacturer's guideline when operating medical equipment;
- Evaluates new equipment and study their mode of operation;
- Collaborates with healthcare professionals to communicate relevant information and work as a team to achieve a common objective;
- Modifies patient treatment plans to adjust to changing conditions and responses;
- Provides recommendations to individuals/groups on ways to prevent diseases and maintain good health;
- Attends educational workshops to enhance professional and technical knowledge.

Qualifications. Applicants must possess a Bachelor's degree in Nursing from an accredited institution and/or a Registered Nurse Diploma and a minimum of five (5) years nursing experience.
