Assistant Professor, Physical & General Chemistry

University of The Bahamas, College of Pure & Applied Sciences is pleased to invite applications for the position of Assistant Professor, Physical & General Chemistry. This full-time appointment will commence August 2026.

The School of Chemistry, Environmental & Life Sciences is seeking a faculty member who is credentialed to teach bachelor-level introductory and advanced content in the area of General and Physical chemistry, with a strong record of undergraduate teaching and research. The successful candidates should demonstrate the potential to work collaboratively in establishing a research agenda relevant to the Bahamian context. Candidates should have a strong background in the following: Physical Chemistry, Instrumentation Analyses and General Chemistry. A strong diverse Chemistry background will be an asset.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Reporting to the Chair of the School of Chemistry, Environmental & Life Sciences, the Assistant Professor, Physical & General Chemistry shall:

- Teach bachelor-level content area introductory and advanced courses;
- Participate in curriculum review, revision and development;
- Participate in academic advising;
- Engage in research and scholarly activities; and
- Serve on departmental, school and college-wide committees;
- Collaborate with colleagues regarding similar research interests and co-curricular activities; and

- Work with faculty, staff and students in a professional manner.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Ability to work independently and/or as part of a team;
- Possess excellent organizational, communication, time management, and interpersonal skills;
- Experience in supervising student research;
- Knowledge of course development techniques and teaching strategies;
- Commitment to professional development and student success;
- Discretion and prudent judgment when dealing with confidential matters.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must have an earned terminal degree in the area of Physical Chemistry from an internationally recognized and accredited institution and a minimum of three (3) years of full-time teaching, research and scholarship at the tertiary level.

Applicants with a Master's degree in Physical Chemistry with a minimum of five (5) years of tertiary-level teaching and a strong record of research may be considered.

SETTING

University of The Bahamas (UB) is a vital catalyst for national development. Chartered on 10th November 2016, UB had its genesis in The College of The Bahamas which was established in 1974. Since 1995, the institution's academic offerings have expanded through the introduction of baccalaureate degree programmes offered across a broad range of approximately 60 majors. Master's degree programmes have included an MBA and an MSc in Reading and Inclusive Education as well as graduate degree programmes offered in collaboration with various US universities. UB operates from the Oakes Field Campus and the Grosvenor Close Centre in New Providence; UB-North in Grand Bahama; and the Gerace Research Facility in San Salvador. Additional sites are planned for throughout the archipelago.
