Dr. Shamel Rolle-Sands



Dr. Shamel Rolle-Sands is a Registered Nurse, Nurse Educator, and Certified Manager whose illustrious career spans over three decades. Like Vince Lombardi, Dr. Rolle-Sands believes that “if we chase perfection, we will catch excellence”.

For 17 years Dr. Rolle-Sands served with distinction as a nurse clinician and nurse educator through deployments in New Providence and Grand Bahama. As the Coordinator for the Continuing Nursing Education Department, Grand Bahama Health Services, she developed and implemented the New Graduate Preceptorship Program, which continues to facilitate the transition of recently graduated Registered Nurses into the acute care practice environment. Dr. Rolle-Sands’ service hallmarked by excellence continues in academia. For over a decade, she has facilitated the learning experiences of nursing students enrolled in local and international diploma/certificate, undergraduate, and postgraduate programs. She is currently an adjunct Assistant Professor in the Department of Nursing.

Dr. Rolle-Sands is a published author and international speaker who continues to contribute to both the scholarly and non-academic communities. She has received several community and nursing awards for outstanding contributions to nursing education and nursing service. In 2017, she received the Nurses’ Association of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas Biennial Zenith Award for Distinguished Service in Nursing Education. In February 2023, Dr. Rolle-Sands was one of 16 women in the Grand Bahama community honored by the Grand Bahama Port Authority and ALIV for outstanding excellence in science. She credits her success to her faith in God and her village of support. To date, Dr. Rolle-Sands’ greatest privilege and achievement has been raising her now adult daughter Shavonne Sherman. She is a world-traveler who enjoys cooking, baking, and choral singing.
