The School of Mathematics, Physics & Technology is seeking a faculty member with a strong commitment to excellence in undergraduate teaching and a record of excellence in research. We are assembling a strong contingent of talented, creative and enthusiastic faculty who can benefit from and contribute to our academic programmes.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Reporting to the Chair of the School of Mathematics, Physics & Technology, the Assistant Professor, Mechanical Engineering and Technology shall:

- Teach associates and bachelor-level content area courses;
- Participate in curriculum/programme review, revision and development;
- Participate in academic advising;
- Engage in research and scholarly activities;
- Possess strong expertise and function fluently at the interface between various engineering and technology disciplines;
- Exhibit a very clear tendency toward and competency in Mechanical Engineering and Technology;

- Serve on departmental, school and college-wide committees.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Ability to teach undergraduate courses in mechanical engineering and engineering technology;
- Ability to conduct research and publish findings in academic journals in these areas;
- Ability to contribute to the development of undergraduate courses and expansion of our programs in mechanical engineering and technology from their current associate degree level to the bachelor degree level.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates should have an earned terminal degree in Mechanical Engineering (or a related field) from an internationally recognized and accredited institution and evidence of research and scholarship. Industry experience would be advantageous.
