Academic Symbolism

The University Mace

The Academic Ceremonial Mace represents the authority of the Chief Executive Officer of the University. The Mace of University of The Bahamas measures three feet in length and is made from native mahogany for its strength and beauty. It is topped by the University crest flanked by two flamingoes, a symbol of our heritage and brilliance and the national bird of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. The Mace was designed and carved by Andret John, a noted Bahamian artist who is famous for his sculptures.

The Presidential Chain and Medallion

The Presidential Chain and Medallion are symbols of the rank of President and the authority of the Office of President. The bronze medallion is antique silver-plated and depicts the University's crest. The chain, plain and unadorned, is joined to the medallion by the President's banner, engraved with the name of the University's President. Together with the Mace, the chain and medallion symbolize the continuing authority of the President of University of The Bahamas.

Academic Dress

The wearing of caps, gowns and hoods at college and university functions dates back to the earliest days of the oldest universities. Modern academic regalia evolved from the kinds of apparel worn by monks and students in the eleventh and twelfth centuries to keep warm in the medieval castles and halls in which they studied.

The Gown

The gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress or rank or social standing. The sleeves of the gown indicate the level of the degree held by the wearer. A long pointed sleeve indicates the bachelor degree. The master's degree gown has an oblong sleeve cut in an arc with a slit at either the upper arm or wrist. The doctoral gown has bell shaped sleeves and may also have velvet facing and three sleeve bars or chevrons. The sleeves of a university president's gown bear four chevrons. The trimming may be black or it may match the degree colour on the gown's edging.

The Cap

The academic cap is a sign of the freedom of scholarship and responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square, symbolizing the book, although other authorities claim that it is a mortarboard, the symbol of the mason, a privileged guild. Trustees wear a six-sided cap, while the President's is eight-sided. The colour of the tassels on the cap denotes the discipline. The tassels on the mortarboards worn by faculty may be black or a colour indicating the degree. Those who hold a doctoral degree may wear a gold tassel.

Engineering – Orange Sciences – Gold
Finance – Drab Social Studies – Citron
General Studies – White Sociology – Citron

Geography – White Technology – Gold
History – White

The Hood

Journalism - Crimson

Language and Literature - White

The hood is the most prominent feature of the academic costume and is lined with the official colours of the institution conferring the degree. It is edged and bound with velvet or the colour appropriate to the degree. At University of The Bahamas, the lining of the hood is royal blue and white representing the University's colours.

The Cord

The gold cord is worn by candidates graduating with distinction. The cumulative grade point average required for the award of distinction is 3.51 - 4.00, effective Fall 1998.

Mr. Gerry Deveaux Producer, Creative Director, Culture Ambassador

His Excellency Gerry Deveaux holds a unique position at the intersection of entertainment, philanthropy, business and culture. Whether it's presenting TV programmes with Karl Lagerfeld creative directing GQ Magazine cover shoots with Lenny Kravitz or writing and producing hit songs for Vanessa Paradis or Angie Stone on his own record label DeVox (Sony/BMG), He is one of the Bahamas' and the world's premier songwriter/producers and an award-winning Creative Director.

From The Bahamas and educated in several countries, Deveaux has put his knowledge of various cultures and languages to good use building an international reputation of style and excellence.

Deveaux matriculated through the educational system in The Bahamas; Chipingham Primary - Nassau

Oakes Field Primary - Nassau St Andrews - Nassau

Queen's College - Nassau, and pursued tertiary studies at the Sorbonne University of Paris, France, and the Complutense, University of Madrid, Spain and the Arts Education School, London.

Deveaux, along with legendary beauty creative Dame Pat McGrath, is Co-founder of the renowned cosmetics brand Pat McGrath Labs. Together, their partnership has garnered acclaim with hyper coveted products that often sell out within minutes of launch.

Deveaux grew up in and was heavily influenced by St Michael's Methodist Church, Boyd Subdivision Nassau where he credits the positive influence of growing up in church with his later direction including his creating the Be Cool Be Nice global kindness movement which was in many ways inspired by the lessons he learned in Sunday School and church.

Deveaux' Be Cool Be Nice movement, brought together some of the world's leading designers, creatives and influencers to promote global messages of kindness and anti- bullying. Be Cool Be Nice became a pop culture hit through various global partnerships including Burberry, Marc Jacobs, Viacom Networks (Nickelodeon, MTV), 14 billboards in New York's Times Square, an unprecedented Snapchat collaboration and the Be Cool Be Nice book authored by Deveaux.

Deveaux was Editor at Large for Tatler Magazine and GQ (Conde Nast) and style consultant for MTV co-hosting shows like MTV Style. Deveaux' other TV projects include producing and presenting the BBC World series 'Living Style with Gerry DeVeaux'. Gerry Deveaux was Special International Correspondent for E! Entertainment Networks (NBC/Universal).

Deveaux is an award-winning writer and producer who was signed through his company Bahama Rhythm Music to a long-term global songwriter/publishing contract with Warner Chappell Music. This contract was initially signed for three years and went on for over two decades during which time Deveaux wrote and produced many multi-platinum Award winning hits including the number 1 Grammy Nominated song 'Never Miss the Water' for Chaka Khan, the international hit 'Heaven Help' for Lenny Kravitz and the global hit 'Be My Baby' for French star Vanessa Paradis. Deveaux's songs and compositions have been featured in many hit films including Shaft starring Samuel L Jackson and successful TV shows including Friends and The Sopranos.

Deveaux was in the unique position to also be signed to various other multinational music contracts including a label deal with Toshiba/EMI, an artist deal with Sony Japan and a global label/production deal with BMG later Sony/BMG where he signed and produced the ground-breaking artist Angie Stone. Stone's debut DeVox/BMG album 'Black Diamond' was voted 'Best Album of The Year' by Billboard Magazine. Deveaux was and still is one of the youngest songwriter/producer/artists to be offered their own label through a major international record company.

Deveaux's many international music awards include the ASCAP (American Society of Composers Authors and Publishers) Award for most performed song and over 200 global Gold, Platinum, Multi-Platinum and Diamond Awards for songs written/composed and/or produced by Deveaux

Deveaux was among several exemplary Bahamians honoured during The Bahamas 30th Anniversary of Independence in July 2003.

Since October 2021 Deveaux is Ambassador at Large for the Commonwealth of The Bahamas focusing on the important areas of culture and the arts.
