Academic Symbolism

The University Mace

The Academic Ceremonial Mace represents the authority of the Chief Executive Officer of the University. The Mace of University of The Bahamas measures three feet in length and is made from native mahogany for its strength and beauty. It is topped by the University crest flanked by two flamingoes, a symbol of our heritage and brilliance and the national bird of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. The Mace was designed and carved by Andret John, a noted Bahamian artist who is famous for his sculptures.

The Presidential Chain and Medallion

The Presidential Chain and Medallion are symbols of the rank of President and the authority of the Office of President. The bronze medallion is antique silver-plated and depicts the University's crest. The chain, plain and unadorned, is joined to the medallion by the President's banner, engraved with the name of the University's President. Together with the Mace, the chain and medallion symbolize the continuing authority of the President of University of The Bahamas.

Academic Dress

The wearing of caps, gowns and hoods at college and university functions dates back to the earliest days of the oldest universities. Modern academic regalia evolved from the kinds of apparel worn by monks and students in the eleventh and twelfth centuries to keep warm in the medieval castles and halls in which they studied.

The Gown

The gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress or rank or social standing. The sleeves of the gown indicate the level of the degree held by the wearer. A long pointed sleeve indicates the bachelor degree. The master's degree gown has an oblong sleeve cut in an arc with a slit at either the upper arm or wrist. The doctoral gown has bell shaped sleeves and may also have velvet facing and three sleeve bars or chevrons. The sleeves of a university president's gown bear four chevrons. The trimming may be black or it may match the degree colour on the gown's edging.

The Cap

The academic cap is a sign of the freedom of scholarship and responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square, symbolizing the book, although other authorities claim that it is a mortarboard, the symbol of the mason, a privileged guild. Trustees wear a six-sided cap, while the President's is eight-sided. The colour of the tassels on the cap denotes the discipline. The tassels on the mortarboards worn by faculty may be black or a colour indicating the degree. Those who hold a doctoral degree may wear a gold tassel.

The Hood

The hood is the most prominent feature of the academic costume and is lined with the official colours of the institution conferring the degree. It is edged and bound with velvet or the colour appropriate to the degree. At University of The Bahamas, the lining of the hood is royal blue and white representing the University's colours.

The Cord

The gold cord is worn by candidates graduating with distinction. The cumulative grade point average required for the award of distinction is 3.51 – 4.00, effective Fall 1998.

University of The Bahamas Commencement Speaker

Hon. Glenys Hanna-Martin, M.P., *Minister of Education and Technical and Vocational Training*

The Hon. Glenys Margaret Elaine Hanna-Martin, Minister of Education and Technical & Vocational Training, was born in Nassau on October 27, 1958, to the late Hon. Arthur Dion Hanna and the late Beryl Hanna (nee Church).

She received her education at St Anne's School, Fox Hill, and Queen's College, Nassau. She later matriculated from Padworth College, Reading, England. She continued her studies at York University, Toronto, Canada, graduating in 1981 with a Bachelor of Arts degree (Specialized Honours) in English Literature. That same year she joined the Public Service as an Executive Officer in the Ministry of Education.

In 1985, Mrs. Hanna-Martin left for the University of Buckingham, England, where, in 1987, she obtained her LLB degree with top honours having been awarded the Maxwell Law Prize by that institution. She then joined the Inner Temple, London, and in 1988, after having successfully completed her Council of Legal Education course, Mrs. Hanna-Martin was called to the Bar of England and Wales, and then to the Bahamas Bar. Later that year she was admitted as an attorney of the Supreme Court of The Bahamas and joined the firm of Arthur D. Hanna & Co.

In 1998, she was elected Chairperson of the Women's Branch of the Progressive Liberal Party. Then, in 2008, was elected Chairman of the Progressive Liberal Party at its National Convention, becoming the first female to hold the post of Chairman of any major political party in The Bahamas. She has also served as the Regional Representative of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Women's Association.

Mrs. Hanna-Martin is a five-time PLP Member of Parliament for the Englerston Constituency, having first won the seat in the 2002 General Election, followed by wins in the 2007, 2012, 2017 and 2021 General Elections.

She was first appointed to the Cabinet of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas as Minister of Transport and Aviation in 2002. In 2012, when the Progressive Liberal Party was again elected to govern the country, Mrs. Hanna-Martin served a second term as Minister of Transport and Aviation. On September 20, 2021 (following a landslide victory at the polls), she was sworn in as Minister of Education, Technical & Vocational Training.

An Anglican, Mrs. Hanna-Martin was married to the late Leon A. Martin and is the mother of three.

Anastarcia Palacious is an author, television host, transformational speaker, and media coach. Anastarcia has over 70,000 hours of public speaking experience and has filmed over 750 episodes of live TV in the past five years. As a master storyteller, she has coached over 340 international business leaders in 43 countries on camera confidence, public speaking, and style.

Anastarcia is a master moderator and has also served as the moderator at the 9th Regional Conference of Commonwealth Women Parliamentarians in 2014, as the moderator of the Annual Meeting of the Boards of Governors of the IDB in 2016 and in that same year, moderated the Bahamas Independence Celebrations. She also co-moderated the first National Bahamas Debate Series in 2021.

A former marketing manager for Atlantis, the Social Media Manager for the first Bahamas Junkanoo Carnival, and the former Associate Director of Advancement for the Access Accelerator Small Business Development Centre, she has worked with some of the most well-known brands in The Bahamas. As the owner of The Social Light Media, Anastarcia brings the same creativity and focus that allowed her to build her personal influencer brand to individuals, businesses, and organizations. She has provided her communication expertise in national campaigns for women and youth rights.

As the Youth Ambassador of The Bahamas to the Commonwealth 2007-2009, The College of The Bahamas Student Union President 2008-2009, and University of Miami Student Government Chief of Staff External 2010-2011, Anastarcia has traveled to over fifteen countries around the world to advocate for and create legislation regarding youth rights. She has served on several government boards over the years.

Anastarcia is listed on Freeport City Council's Wall of Fame and has won and been nominated for numerous awards. She is married to entrepreneur, environmentalist, and businessman Carlos Palacious. The couple has two children, Cairo and Chosen.
